Goodwill Can Accept:

- Clean clothing (men, women, children, and infant)
- Shoes/boots (in pairs)
- Garden tools, hand tools
- Housewares, dishes, pots/pans
- Bedding, linens
- Clean furniture
- Jewelry and accessories
- Small appliances (toasters, crockpots, lamps, clocks)
- Home Decor
- Stuffed animals/toy
- Computers & Electronics
- Books/Magazines
- Media (VHS, DVD, CD)
- Games (board, yard, video)
- Sporting goods & equipment
- Home computers & electronics

Goodwill is Unable to Accept:

- TVs, Console TVs & Console Stereos
- Microwaves
- Hazardous waste/chemicals, lubricants
- Plumbing fixtures/Scrap Building Materials
- Large appliances (refrigerators, dryers, etc.)
- Used tires, paint/oil
- Dehumidifiers/humidifiers
- Waterbeds
- Furniture in need of repair or cleaning
- Desks larger than 5 feet long or metal
- Pianos/organs
- Encyclopedias
- Car seats or cribs
- Large copy machines
- Electronic beds/hospital beds
- Food
- Pool tables

Brush and Landfill Items

Brush may not include grass clippings, leaves or branches less than 1" in diameter.

Landfill items may not include household garbage, household hazardous waste or liquids of any kind.

Paper & Cardboard:

Paper Products - Junk Mail, Magazines, Newspaper, Phone Books, Office Paper, Shredded Paper, Wrapping Paper, Hardcover and Paperback Books, Game/Sports Cards etc. Cardboard & **Corrugated Board** - Cereal Boxes, Shoe Boxes, Paper Towel Rolls, Shipping Boxes, etc.

***No Paper Towels, Kleenex, Napkins, Wax Coated Milk or Juice Cartons, Ice Cream Containers**

Glass:

Clear, Brown, Green & Blue Bottles & Jars

***No Light Bulbs, Pyrex, Mirrors, Picture Glass, Candle Jars or Perfume Bottles**

Metals:

Aluminum Cans, (Clean) Aluminum Foil & Pie Plates, Tin Cans, Steel/Iron, Copper, Brass, Other Aluminum.

Scrap Metal

Pots & Pans, Popcorn Tins, Muffin Tins, Ironing Boards, Hangers, Metal Shelving, Metal Patio Furniture, Metal Ladders, Guttering, Piping, Fencing, Cutlery, Knives, Swords, Throwing Stars, Scissors, Staplers, Garbage Disposals, Metal Car Parts – Ex – Brakes, Rotors, Rims, Etc. Tools – Ex – Shovels, Rakes, Hammers, Screwdrivers, Pliers, Etc.

Plastics:

Plastic Bottles #1 - #7 - This includes all Household Food & Beverage, Cleaning Supplies and Prescription Bottles with a recycling triangle with a #1-#7 on it.

***No Styrofoam, Motor Oil Bottles, Plastic Utensils, Straws, Ziploc bags, Candy or Chip Wrappers, Dept Store or Grocery Store Bags, Food Bags or Plastic Packaging, etc.**

Batteries:

Cell Phone Batteries, Laptop Batteries, UPS Batteries, Lead Acid Batteries (Car, Boat, RV, Motorcycle, Alarm Systems, Etc.)

***No Alkaline or button batteries**

Misc Items:

Natural Cork – From Wine Bottles/Cork Board, Prescription Glasses & Sunglasses, Foreign & US Coins & Paper Currency, Jewelry & Watches, Bicycles, Fishing Poles & Gear, Boats/Canoes (except inflatables)

Computer Equipment & Parts:

Towers, Laptops, Small Form Factors, Tablets, Flat Screen Monitors, Hard Drives, Laptop Batteries, Memory, Processors, Computer Boards, CD Rom's, Power Supplies, Cords, Keyboards, Mice, Speakers, Microphones, Mini-Cams, External Hard Drives Docking Stations, Zip Drives, Data Tapes, Modems, Routers, Network Devices, Printers, Ink Jets & Toner Cartridges, Scanners, UPS Backups

Other Electronics:

CRT, LCD, Plasma TV's – \$1.50 per inch (If it's heavy & thick it'll probably be this)

Flat Screen TV's (over 36") – \$10

CRT Computer Monitors – \$10

Console TV's – \$75 (Yes – some people still have them)

Lawnmowers, Snow Blowers, Grills, Exercise Equip, Ovens,

Dishwashers – \$10
